Lawrence was part of a distinguished Dublin family of miniaturists. His brothers John Lawrence and Robert were also practitioners. George entered the Dublin Society's Drawing Schools in 1771. He was awarded a prize for a drawing of a head and figure. After leaving the school, he worked as a miniaturist and pastellist.
